- Layers: in the summer t-shirt or tank top, long sleeved shirt; in the winter sweatshirt, jacket, gloves, snow boots (in addition to riding boots)

What NOT To Bring For Riding:

- Sandals and tennis shoes for riding
- Shorts or baggy pants
- Loose jewelry, such as long earrings, bracelets or necklaces
